This lesson it is suggested that each student is assigned two chimes creating eleven High positions: Concentration Position 1 – C4, D4 (Core) Position 2 – E4, F4 Position 3 - G4, A4 Position 4 – Bb4, B4, C5 Position 5 – D5, E5 Position 6 - F5, G5 **Position 7 – A5, B5, Bb5** Position 8 – C6, D6 Position 9 - E6, F6 **Position 10 – G6, A6 Position 11 – Bb6, B6, C7** Students will need to take on the roles of "Ringers" and "Waiters" with only eleven positions unless you have more than one set of chimes. Practice previously clapped rhythms using chimes paying close attention to ringing and damping techniques. You may want to incorporate a stopped sound technique while playing rhythms. Review different techniques from Lesson 6. Read "Reno Boogie" • All chimes read rhythms in measures with different techniques and practice Practice ringing repeated eighth notes while counting out loud (1 and, 2 and, 3 and, 4and) being careful to keep steady beat Isolate and practice Bass line, finding places in the piece where it repeats. Isolate and practice Treble line, finding places in the piece where it repeats. Put the whole piece together As students return their chimes to the cases encourage them to describe one technique that Closing may be used with the chimes. (Wrap-up)
